Area Served:	Lake and Porter County Indiana & Southern Cook County Illinois				
League Members:	Approximately 900 members, on 140+ teams in 18 divisions and growing				
League Year:	Every league year starts on or around June 1st and ends May 31st				
League Membership:	The APA annual membership is \$25. Membership allows you to participate in all APA teams and events.				
Sessions:	 Three sessions per league year. Session 1: Begins in June for 16 weeks Session 2: Begins in September for 16 weeks Session 3: Begins in January for 16 weeks 				
Divisions:	Generally, we structure the divisions so that the bars/locations that the teams play out of are within close proximity of each other in an attempt to keep travel to a minimum. The formats we offer for the divisions are: 8-BALL, 9-BALL, Masters, and Double Jeopardy (which is both 8-Ball and 9-BALL on the same night.). Division Playoffs, Tri-Cups and Cash Cups are at the end of the session.				
Teams:	Each division has about 6-16 teams with 5-8 players on a team. Only 5 players play each week and your team competes once a week against other teams in your division. You can play on more than one team but they must be in different divisions. The weekly team fee is \$40.				
Skill Levels:	8-Ball players are assigned a skill level anywhere between 2 thru 7 with 7 being the better players. The skill levels are similar in 9-Ball. Skill levels, 2, 3, and 4 make up the majority of the League.

Weekly Team Match-Ups:	The skill levels of the 5 players that play their match each week cannot exceed 23. This way, teams are not allowed to have only strong players and dominate the league. Example: Skill Levels 7,6,4,4,2 = 23 or $6,5,5,3,3 = 22$ or $6,6,4,4,3 = 23$				
Tri-Cup Tournament: Cash Cup Tournament:	At the end of each of the three sessions, teams that do well during weekly play and playoff matches advance to the Tri-Cup Tournament and compete with top teams from other divisions. Tri-Cup winners advance to Cash Cup with top teams receiving cash payouts. Also, top finishing teams from the Tri-Cup Tournaments compete in the Citywide Tournament.				
Citywide Tournament:	This annual tournament is held in June. Teams qualify for this tournament by being the top finishing teams from the Tri-Cup Tournaments. The Citywide Tournament winning teams advance to Las Vegas to compete in the APA National Team Championships.				
National Team Championships:	Winners of the Citywide Tournament compete in the National Team Championships in Las Vegas in August. We have a Travel Assistance Fund that provides travel and lodging assistance for teams advancing to Las Vegas.
